Lent is just around the corner—Ash Wednesday is March 1st.
We will have two Ash Wednesday Masses—8:45am and 7:00pm.



Beginning on Fridays during Lent, we will have our Lenten Soup Suppers at 6:00pm in the Multi-Purpose Room, followed by Stations of the Cross at 7:00pm in the church.



Once again, our parish will be supporting Catholic Relief Services with their Rice Bowl program. They have provided us with information on how the Rice Bowl program works, and how our parish community can join in and encounter ourselves, encounter our neighbors, encounter our God and encounter Lent.

Encounter Lent.

We are called to build a culture of encounter. Jesus made that clear from the way he lived, the message he preached. Pope Francis makes that clear by his own daily example. And we have a host of holy men and women who have come before us, who have gone to the margins of society so that every member of our human family might know the love of God.

CRS Rice Bowl provides resources to bring Lenten spirituality to life for families and parish and school communities, while continuing to connect Catholics in our diocese with those in need around the world.

Our diocese will join with more than 13,000 faith communities in 180 dioceses around the U.S. in prayer, fasting and almsgiving this Lent. Together, we will serve our brothers and sisters most in need around the world while forming families and faith communities in global solidarity. 25% of Rice Bowl donations remain here in Eastern Washington to fund small grants to hunger and nutrition programs around the diocese.
