Congratulations to Principal TJ Romano & Assumption Parish School! The Nazareth Guild has awarded the school two substantial grants for the 2017-18 school year. The first grant is the Nazareth Guild Special Needs Grant for \$5,000 which will be used to purchase Chromebooks to help implement a 1-1 technology model in grades 6-8. Each student will then have a Chromebook assigned to them for use during the school day. Teachers are being trained on the Google Education Applications such as Google Docs, Sheets, Slides, Sites, Calendar and Classroom to enhance instructional practices. Students will then learn multiple ways to use and demonstrate their knowledge through these applications.

The second grant is the \$8,000 School Impact Grant which allows the school the opportunity to improve students learning experience in science. FOSS Kits—which provide exceptional science experiments by engaging students in science through active learning—will be purchased for Kindergarten through 8th grade. A very special thanks to Kathleen Arnold and Karen Round for their work in preparing this grant.

Assumption Parish School continues to educate children in the vision and faith tradition of the Roman Catholic Church, with an eye to the future in making sure the students are well-equipped to handle the demands of an ever-increasing technological society.
