## June 4, 2017 Pentecost



*Pentecost Sunday* marks for us the end of the Easter season, yet we continue on with a particular focus for the next two weeks—next week is the celebration of the Most Holy Trinity, and the following weekend is the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, or Corpus Christi.

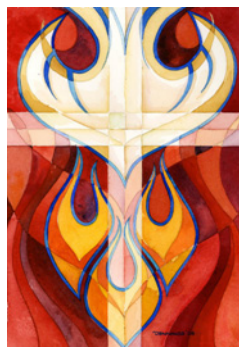
Pentecost marks the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples gathered together in the upper room—not only the manifestation of unique and holy gifts, but the universal outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon all who are gathered together—the infusion of the Holy Spirit into the Church. It is the manifestation of the Church as something more than simply followers of Christ coincidentally gathered in one location who are recipients of those gifts, but the establishment of the Church so that we might be one in Christ, one in communion and one in faith. From this point forward, sent out into the world to proclaim the Good News to the ends of the earth.

Sometimes it seems as though we have lost or misplaced that radical sense of the presence of the Holy Spirit, yet the Advocate comes to us now as it always has.

John Henry Newman put it in this way: The Advocate, “the ‘inner Master’ leads to the greater and greater penetration of the mystery of Jesus and of the Father whom the Son reveals. ‘This teaches us, at least for the future, to have faith in what we do not see. The world seems to follow its well-trodden path. There is nothing heavenly on the face of society; in the day’s news, there is nothing of heaven; on the faces of the masses or the great or wealthy or mighty, there is nothing of heaven; in the speech of the eloquent, in the actions of the powerful, in the counsels of wise men, in pomp and splendor, there is nothing of heaven’.

And yet, the Spirit of God is present...

Let us always keep this divine truth in our minds:  
the more hidden God’s hand, the more powerful it is;  
The more it is silent, the more it is formidable.  
We are in the powerful service of the Spirit...”
